



Treaty of Fraternity and Good Will between the
Popular Republic of Nargesalem and the Republic
of Checkland

Article 1

Mutual Recognition and Cooperation

The Popular Republic of Nargesalem and Republic of Checkland (the Signatory Parties) grant their diplomatic recognition to one-another as Sovereign States and shall respect each other as such, in that they shall not infringe nor intrude on the territorial integrity of one-another.

An official state of alliance is established between the Signatory Parties, in that they shall maintain regular communication, economic cooperation, and cultural exchange.

Article 2

Provisions for a Good Peace

It is resolved that each Signatory Party is to maintain the respect for the other Party's choices in the course of economic, political, and cultural development.

The Signatory Parties must abstain from the collusion of the other Party's internal affairs - save for when requested to mediate in those affairs - in that they are vested an obligation to refrain from the use of force to impact with negative effects the Good Peace. Furthermore, the Parties are also vested an obligation to refrain from the support, aid, or otherwise abetting official Enemies of the other Party - this also includes any States, groups, or entity that engages in conflict, hostility, or other forms of asymmetric aggression towards the Signatory Parties.

Article 3

Consultation and Defense of the Other

In the situation that the governing instruments or institutions of one of the Parties is threatened, they may request the consultation of the other Party.

The Signatory Parties may elect to proscribe diplomatic or logistic assistance to the other Party in the case of immediate institutional threat.

Article 4

Effectiveness of this Treaty

This treaty will enter into force upon the signature of the Heads of Government of both Signatory Parties.


This treaty may be terminated if one or more of these criteria are met by one of the Signatory Parties:

- the Party ceases to exist in the legal state in which it ratified this treaty,
- the Party elects to withdraw from this treaty,
- a violation of the provisions of this treaty is confirmed to have been made with deliberate intent by the Party.
