



Treaty of Social Commonwealth and Fraternal
Coprosperity between the Popular Republic of
Nargesalem and the People's Democratic Republic
of Arkzelia

Article 1

Basic Provisions

The Popular Republic of Nargesalem and the People's Democratic Republic of Arkzelia (the Signatory Parties) shall grant their recognition to one-another as sovereign States and shall not infringe nor intrude on the territorial integrity of one-another.

Established hence is an alliance in consecration of diplomatic affairs between the Signatory Parties, such friendship including:

- a means to host communication with eachother regarding the common interests of their Nation;
- a means to better the domestic and diplomatic integrity of the other Party;
- a means to better the welfare and trade of the other Party;
- a willingness to assist and aid the other Nation should that Nation see any form of conflict.

Article 2

Provisions for a Good Peace

It is resolved that the Signatory Parties agree to respect the other Party's choices in the course of political, economic, and cultural development. The Signatory Parties further resolve to establish a framework for the cultural and ideological exchange in order to enrich the knowledge economy of eachother.

The Signatory Parties shall not collude or interfere with the internal and domestic affairs of the other Nation.

The Signatory Parties are each vested an obligation to refrain from using force, the threat of force, or any such measures which may disturb the Good Peace of their relations should the situation of any mutual controversy arise between the Signatory Parties. Thus, the Signatory Parties confirm that should any mutual controversy arise between them, that they will resort to solve such issue through peaceable means.

Neither Signatory Party may support, aid, create, or otherwise abet the operation of organizations or entities on the other Party's soil which may impair the territorial integrity or sovereignty of that Party.

Article 3

Defense of the Other

The Signatory Parties are obligated to arrange means for consultation should a situation arise in which it is deemed that the Good Peace is threatened or being undermined by a third entity.

Should one of the Signatory Parties find itself under attack by a third entity, the other Signatory Party may not support, aid, or otherwise abet the operation of that third entity.

Article 4

Effectiveness of this Treaty

This Treaty shall enter force upon its signature by both Signatory Parties.

This Treaty is to be terminated if any of the following Criterion are met:
a violation of these Articles by one of the Signatory Parties is confirmed to have been committed with intent;
one of the Signatory Parties elect to withdraw from the Treaty;
one of the Signatory Parties ceases to exist in the legal state in which it ratified this Treaty..
