



Treaty of the Binding of the Black Creek and  
the Little Salt Creek between the Popular  
Republic of Nargesalem and the Federal Columns  
of Arbores

# Article 1

## Basic Provisions

The Popular Republic of Nargesalem and the Federal Columns of Arbores (the Signatory Parties) grant their diplomatic recognition to one-another as independent and sovereign States and shall respect each other as such, in that they will not intrude, impede, or otherwise infringe on the other Party's territorial and institutional integrity.

It is further resolved by the Signatory Parties that they will form an official state of alliance, in that:

the Parties will establish and maintain a channel for regular communication with one-another,

the Parties will establish and maintain a means for cultural exchange,

the Parties will maintain free and open trade and commerce with one-another.

# Article 2

## Provisions for a Good Peace

It is resolved by the Signatory Parties that they must maintain and uphold the respect for the other Party's decisions in their political, economic, and cultural development.

It is further resolved that each Party is vested an obligation to refrain from the collusion or involvement in the other Party's internal affairs - unless requested so by that Party - in that they must abstain from the use of force to impact negatively the Good Peace between the Signatory Parties. The Parties are also vested an obligation to refrain and withhold support, aid, or any other form of abetting towards official Enemies of the other Party, or other States and groups that may threaten the institutional stability of the other Party.

## Article 3

### Defense of the Other

In the situation or case that the political, civil, or governing institutions or instruments of one of the Signatory Parties are threatened, they may request to consult with the other Party.

The Signatory Parties may elect to proscribe their diplomatic and logistic assistance to the other Party in the case of immediate institutional threat or if the consultation between Parties resolves to do as such.

## Article 4

### Effectiveness of this Treaty

This treaty will enter into force upon the signature of both Heads of Government of the Signatory Parties.

The provisions of this treaty may be terminated if one or more of these criteria are met by one of the Signatory Parties:

the Party elects to withdraw from this treaty,

the Party ceases to exist in the legal state in which it entered into this treaty,

a violation of these articles was confirmed to have been made with deliberate intent by the Party.
